



AWAKENING SEED SCHOOL

Dear Parents,

Here is our 2006 offering of summer classes. Our summer program is a blend of engaging, educational content in a joyful and relaxing atmosphere. We have designed the classes around weekly themes for the entire school. Yoga will be available again this summer for all age groups. Children may come for the entire summer or attend on a weekly basis. All students must attend five days, with the exception of the toddlers and 2's/3's preschool classes. Preschool and toddler students may attend just mornings or come for the whole day.

In order to enroll, a registration fee must be paid. Amounts vary, depending on the number of weeks attending. See the tuition rates on the back of this brochure. Tuition for June is due by May 15th, and July tuition is due by June 15th. After school rates and arrangements are included with the tuition information.

REGISTRATION WILL BE HANDLED ON A FIRST COME, FIRST SERVED BASIS, SO EARLY REGISTRATION IS RECOMMENDED. You may register any time during the spring and add classes during the summer; however, we appreciate early registration as it helps our teaching staff plan their summer schedule.

PLEASE NOTE:

- If you want to enroll a child in the toddler program, please call the school prior to sending a deposit. We have a waiting list for this class and must first fill the class with children currently enrolled or on the waiting list.
- Our summer internship program is available again this year for 12-15 year olds. Students need to apply for this program and must be former Seeds to enroll.
- Only students in the toddler class may be in diapers. All students in other preschool classes must be reliably potty trained. The toddler classroom is the only one equipped for diaper changing and violation of this could jeopardize our licensing. We appreciate your respecting this policy.

Summer classes are available to all children, regardless of previous enrollment. We recommend that new students enrolling for the fall spend a couple of summer weeks at

the Seed to adjust to the new environment. Children who do this tend to make an easier transition in the fall.

Placement in classes will be determined by the grade level a child will be entering in the fall. If a child has finished 1st grade (going into 2nd grade) he/she would enroll in the 2nd-6th grade class.

Please note that all students must show proof of immunization. If your child is currently enrolled at the Seed, or has been enrolled previously and immunization information is on file, you may disregard the immunization portion of the registration form. **NO NEW STUDENT WILL BE PERMITTED TO ENROLL WITHOUT IMMUNIZATION DATA.**

The school opens at 7:30 a.m. and classes begin at 9:00 a.m. Children may arrive any time before 9:00 with no additional charge. Part day toddlers must be picked up by 12:00 p.m. and all other part day students must be picked up by 12:25. The regular school day ends at 3:00 p.m. After school care is available until 6:00 p.m. for an additional charge. A daily snack is provided for all after school students. **STUDENTS MUST BE PICKED UP NO LATER THAN 6:00 P.M.** Toddlers in the after school program must be picked up by 5:30 p.m. A \$20.00 late fee will be charged for any children picked up after 6:00 p.m. or toddler picked up after 5:30. No exceptions will be made.

The success of our summer program is vital to the school's well-being and is an excellent way to enrich your child's learning process. By filling our summer program we are able to meet our budget and continue to provide the same quality programming each year.
