## Our Patchwork Planet: A Celebration of Diversity

Since 1977, Awakening Seed School has provided a quality educational program for children in the Phoenix area, promoting creativity, innovation, and healthy living. Honoring life's diversity is an on-going part of the Seed curriculum, and this summer's school-wide theme, **Our Patchwork Planet: A Celebration of Diversity**, will be another expression of the Seed's vision. Each of the six weeks will focus on a cultural component that expresses uniqueness, including food, names, family, clothing, language, and celebrations. Throughout the school, students will explore sameness and difference in age appropriate ways. In doing so, we pave the way for a future that is populated with global citizens who will be able to work side by side with others, regardless of individual differences. Each student attending the Seed summer program will receive a commemorative t-shirt and our annual summer food drive for Tanner Chapel Food pantry will round out the summer's activities. ## ABOUT THE SUMMER PROGRAM

The summer program has grown out of our regular curriculum and is offered as a creative and enjoyable option during June and July. It is available for toddlers through children entering the 6th grade. A summer internship program is available for students ages 12-15. This program is separate from the regular school year and is open to current and former Seeds, as well as children who attend other schools. In addition to the educational program, children have yoga instruction, music, water play, and outdoor recreational time. After school care is also available.

## CLASSES

Children may attend weekly or for the entire six week session. Toddlers and preschoolers may attend mornings only or full days. Preschool 4s, K-1, and 2nd-6th graders must attend five days. The program for kindergarteners through 6th graders is a full day. Placement in classes is determined by the grade level a child will be going into in the fall. **All children placed in the Preschool 3s class and older MUST BE RELIABLY POTTY TRAINED.**

## REGISTRATION

Early registration is recommended and enrollment will be handled on a first come, first served basis. **Students enrolled all six weeks for five full days will be given priority for registration beginning February 21st until March 2nd.** After that date, spaces will be open to other students. ## FEES AND DEPOSITS

All fees and deposit are **non-refundable**. Students will be enrolled once the registration fee and deposit are paid. **Half of the full summer tuition is due upon registration. The other half is due on May 15th. A late fee will be charged if received after May 31st.** Please read the deposit information carefully for further details.

## PROOF OF IMMUNIZATION

All **new** students must show proof of immunization prior to attending. Please bring a copy of your child's immunization record when you register your child.

### *Clothes and Cosas*

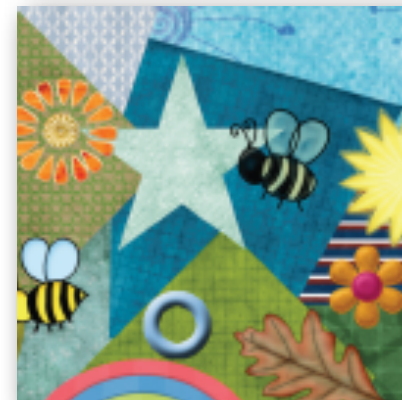

### *In Other Words*

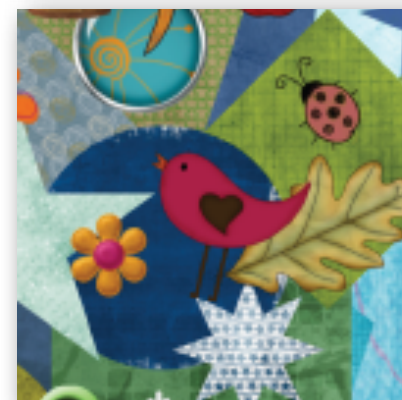
